IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT YOUR DRINKING WATER

**Total Coliform Monitoring Requirements
Not Met for PARADISE SPRINGS July 2023**

Our water system failed to monitor as required for drinking water standards during the July 2023; therefore, was in violation of the regulations. Although this is not an emergency, as our customers, you have a right to know what happened, what you should do, and what we did to correct the situation.

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During July 2023, we did not collect 3 routine samples the month following a positive routine sample distribution system; therefore, cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What should I do?

- There is nothing you need to do at this time.
- The table below lists the contaminant we did not properly test for during the July 2023, how many samples we are required to take and how often, how many samples we took, when samples should have been taken, and the date on which follow-up samples were OR will be taken.
